Moms Clean Air Force in Ohio is a grassroots children's health organization comprised of 14,000 parents and involved citizens dedicated to reducing harmful carbon emissions, supporting action to curb climate change impacts, and promoting investment in clean energy and energy efficiency to improve health and reduce consumer costs. Our work is done through online activity, offline grassroots activism, and state and federal advocacy efforts.
