## NV MOMS JOIN MEMBERS OF CONGRESS ON CAPITOL HILL AS PART OF SWEEPING MOVEMENT FOR CLIMATE SOLUTIONS

Moms Clean Air Force to Host "Play-In" Demanding Lawmakers Solve our Climate Crisis

(Washington, D.C.) – On Thursday, July 11<sup>th</sup>, two moms from Nevada will join more than **500 members from over 25 states** to gather at the U.S. Capitol for the **sixth** Moms Clean Air Force "Play-In" for Climate Action and live-streamed press conference. This annual event will showcase visionary leaders including members of the Global Climate Strikes who will join moms and Members of Congress on stage to demand action on climate. Speakers of all generations will be calling on political leadership at all levels to advance solutions to protect our families from the climate crisis. This means 100% clean energy across the entire economy by 2050.

Following the Play-In, the Nevada moms will head to the Capitol to meet with their members of Congress to share their personal stories and urge their representatives to take action on climate to protect their children's health and future. Rising average temperature in the state are leading to more heat weaves and earlier snow melts in a region already known as one of the driest and hottest in the country. Many families in Nevada are experiencing more intense wildfires. In response, Governor Sisolak has joined the U.S. Climate Alliance, while pushing energy providers to generate at least 50 percent of their power in a renewable form by 2030.

**Cory Hernandez** is a Reno-based mother and proud Latina who is active with Ecomadres, a national partnership between Green Latinos and Moms Clean Air Force that addresses issues of clean air, climate, and toxins that affect the health of Latino children and families. As a community organizer and movement builder, Cory uses her voice to fight for environmental justice and clean air for all, among other issues. Cory believes local solutions are more important than ever as our federal government rolls back critical health and environmental protections.

**Jennifer Ann Cantley** is mother to five active children in Carson City. As the Nevada Field Organizer for Moms Clean Air Force, Jennifer is passionate about speaking up about what is at stake with air pollution. Jennifer's son has asthma, which is exacerbated by air pollution and wildfires. Jennifer also has asthma herself, and she wants
